Historic Sappington House's nearby Route 66 goes south to the musical refrains of Southern Rock. We are connecting time and memories for two outdoor, autumn concerts to raise funds to preserve St. Louis County's oldest brick home, **Historic Sappington House at 1015 S. Sappington Road 63126.**

On **Saturday, October 9, 2021 from 4 to 7 pm, Pat Liston**, formerly of St. Louis favorite **Mama's Pride**, will take you back to his Southern rock roots. Gate tickets

are \$20 per adult and children under 12 are free.

The St. Louis Classic Rock Preservation Society is co-sponsoring the concert.

Concert proceeds will benefit Historic Sappington House in Crestwood. The home was constructed in what was then the Louisiana Territory, 13 years before Missouri statehood. Open to the public as a museum since its restoration in 1966, it is in need of extensive repairs.

But that is only the start! **Historic Sappington House Park hopes to soon feature TWO houses - Thomas' and cousin Joseph Sappington's LOG house built in 1816.** The Sappington House Foundation has pushed our fundraising efforts to a gallop because not only do we need to prepare the **log structure to provide expanded educational, exhibit and event spaces, we must first move it to the park from five miles away!**

Come join us for Pat Liston in concert presented for a good cause! **Mystery gift boxes and 50/50 raffle** tickets will be on sale. **The Barn restaurant onsite** will be offering **food and drink** to buy during concert.
