Spirits in the Windows premiere on **October 8** from 7 to 8:30 pm, after the Battle of the Bands concert. Then on **October 9, 15, 22, 23** and **28** from 6:30 to 8:30 pm, visitors will watch brief pantomimes in five windows, from the front lawn at 1015 S. Sappington Road 63126.

And then on **Saturday, October 29th, 6:30 - 8:30 pm** come inside and listen to the **Spirits of Sappington House** as they talk about their lives and times that occurred in these very rooms 200 years ago.

The event also features colonial surgeon Dr. John Murphy showing off his medical equipment including rusty hacksaws and blood-sucking leeches.
